**Guidelines for the 2019-20 school year
“Hughes Memorial Educational Scholarship”**

This scholarship is dedicated to the memory of Paul and Dottie Hughes. Both were active and valued members of the Community Presbyterian Church of St.Maries, Idaho. They demonstrated through their actions the meaning of community, both spiritually and civically.

The intent of this scholarship is to provide financial support to individuals from both our church body and community of which Paul and Dottie were such an integral part for so many years. This scholarship is made possible through generous donations by those who wish to honor the memory of Paul and Dottie.

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

- **Qualified applicants will be entering at least their junior year of a 4-year higher education school or the second year of a 2-year higher education school.**
- **The applicant does not have to be a current member of the Community Presbyterian Church but past or current involvement with the church, or any relationship to a church member, will be taken into consideration.**
- **This scholarship is not “need-based” but the applicant’s financial position will be taken into consideration if the applicant chooses to disclose such information.**
- **The scholarship selection committee will give preference to those individuals who have shown a willingness to work toward a goal and have become successful at working toward that goal. A Christian attitude paired with a clear direction for the future will be foremost in the minds of the members of the selection committee during the review process.**
- **The scholarship amount varies from year to year depending upon the donations received and the interest generated by the investments.**
- **The “Hughes Memorial Educational Scholarship” application must be completed and returned to the Community Presbyterian Church by June 15, 2019. The selection committee’s decision will be made by Aug.1, 2019. Soon thereafter the applicant will be notified of that decision.**

**2019 Guidelines and Application
for the SECONDARY USE of the
“Hughes Memorial Educational Scholarship”**

PLEASE NOTE: The primary purpose of the “Hughes Memorial Educational Scholarship” is to offer financial support to college students that are pursuing a degree in higher education. This is the original intention of the scholarship fund. Priority is given to these students when granting money from the scholarship fund.

The CPC “Scholarship Committee,” that oversees the scholarship fund, has expanded on this original intention by adding a “SECONDARY USE” category.

This SECONDARY USE category is intended to financially support an activity or a project that a CPC member, or the minor child of a member, may pursue. This activity or project must be Christian-based and must enhance the spiritual growth of the potential recipient.

PLEASE NOTE: Priority for funding from the SECONDARY USE category is given to CPC children that go to Camp Spalding.

Any other activity or project that may possibly be funded, either partially or fully, must be approved by the CPC Scholarship Committee. The availability for funding is determined by the stated worthiness of the activity or project and by the amount of money that is available, if any. Funding is not guaranteed.

The application deadline is a minimum of one month prior to the starting date of the activity or project.
